Lately it isn't just restaurants going out of business, wedding photographers are also feeling the pinch and sometimes taking your irreplaceable memories with them.

"These are the only photos we have now, just a few that some guests have taken so I guess this is all we're going to have," said Beth Delargy. Mike and Beth Delargy's picture perfect wedding turned into a picture nightmare. After their wedding, their photographer A Refined Touch left the country. They finally got their pictures on a disc after 4 In Your Corner stepped in but they still haven't gotten their promised wedding albums.

Jim Jett, the owner of Any Occasion Photo and Videography tells me lately, stories like this are all too common. "I've known five or six in this area alone to go out of business," said Jett. Jett tells me he's been a photographer for more than 30 years and he calls wedding photography one of the fastest dying industries. He says you should be careful before hiring just anyone. "Good chance they'll go out of business, good chance they might not show up, good chance they don't know what they're doing if they do show up," said Jett.

Jett saw the Delargy's story on Fox 4 and decided to jump into the picture. "I felt bad for them and I've heard of this before and I don't want them to get a bad feeling for the industry or for photographers," said Jett. So we went down to the Delargy's home to try and fix their wedding photographer blues. "I heard you had a little problem getting your wedding albums together so I thought we'd come and help you," said Jett to the Delargys. "There's three albums in here and if you need help laying them out or printing them, I will be happy to help you." Now the Delargy's wedding experience is finally picture perfect.

Before hiring a wedding photographer, ask your friends for recommendations. You should also check for complaints through the Better Business Bureau. Jim Jett says you shouldn't choose a photographer based on a low price because you may get what you pay for.
